

By Laws: Disputes of Non-Ethical Nature

- 1. Where there is a dispute between Members that is not related to an ethical issue, the President may assist in the resolution of the dispute.
- 2. The President may delegate the resolution of a dispute to a person or ad hoc committee. Such delegate or delegates act with the authority of the President.
- 3. If appropriate, the disputing Members may be encouraged by the President or their delegate to undertake Mediation conducted by an independent and experienced Mediator. The Mediation will be governed by the rules selected by the Mediator.
- 4. The disputing Members will be jointly responsible for all relevant costs, including those of the President, delegates of the President, any Mediator and any other relevant person.
